The Chicago International Violin Competition is proud to Announce the Young Artist Division -Winners and Laureates for the 2024 CVC Competition... 1st Prize – Stephan Zhang (age 17) from Oklahoma City, OK, USA, 2nd Prize – Dustin Breshears (age 17) from San Francisco, CA, USA, and 3rd Prize – Valery Breshears (age 14) from San Francisco, CA, USA are the Winners of this years' Competition.

After 2 rounds of competition, and over 4 weeks of deliberations by the CVC acclaimed international jury, over 100 contestants from 34 countries competed to be awarded winners of the Chicago Violin Competition. Having such a talented pool of contestants in the Young Artist Division, coming to a decision and awarding winners was a tall order, but CVC is excited to announce that **Stephan Zhang (age 17) from Oklahoma City, OK, USA** has Won the 2024 Young Artist Division in the Chicago Violin Competition.

Both 2nd and 3rd prizes were awarded to the Breshears family - brother and sister from San Francisco, CA, USA. Dustin Breshears (age 17) was awarded the second prize, and Valery Breshears (age 14) was awarded the third prize. Also, 3 Laureates were awarded for the Young Artist Division listed below.

Over 100 applications were received from all over the world for the 2024 Chicago Violin Competition. All Winners and Laureates of the Young Artist Competition are representatives of the USA.

As the winners of the Young Artist Division - Chicago Violin Competition, will receive a cash prize of **USD \$1,500, 1,000, \$500** respectively, along with other performance, masterclass, and other exciting opportunities.
